Single Households

\$ - ~ \$ 1,164 = 0% copay
\$ 1,165 ~ \$ 1,788 = 25% copay
\$ 1,789 ~ \$ 2,412 = 50% copay
\$ 2,413 ~ \$ 3,036 = 75% copay
\$ 3,037 & above = Private Pay Referral

Couples

\$ - ~ \$ 1,577 = 0% copay
\$ 1,578 ~ \$ 2,423 = 25% copay
\$ 2,424 ~ \$ 3,269 = 50% copay
\$ 3,270 ~ \$ 4,115 = 75% copay
\$ 4,116 & above = Private Pay Referral

Co-pay benefits are determined by the average monthly income received from:

- Social Security
- Pension
- Rental Property
- Taxable Interest
- Dividend Earnings
- Wages

Based on 2018 federal poverty rates: single = \$12,140; couple = \$16,389 as issued by the Department of Health and Human Services.
