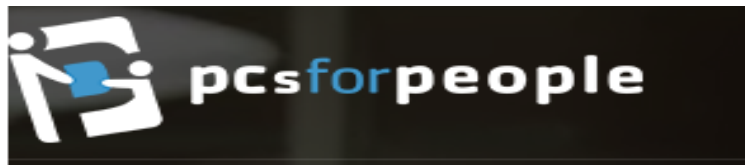

Since 1982 Platte Senior Services, Inc. (PSSI) has served Kansas City and Platte County with essential senior services focusing on seniors who are at risk because of isolation, malnutrition, frailty, illness or disability. PSSI enriches the quality of life for senior citizens by allowing them to remain active and live independently as long as possible in their own homes. Senior nutrition is the main focus for PSSI, offering daily hot, nutritious lunches through the Home Delivered Meals Program, five days a week. PSSI partners with Harvesters to provide monthly commodity food boxes filled with nonperishable healthy food to qualified seniors. We are presently closed following COVID-19 CDC guidelines.
