A free week of camp for the children of older caregivers.

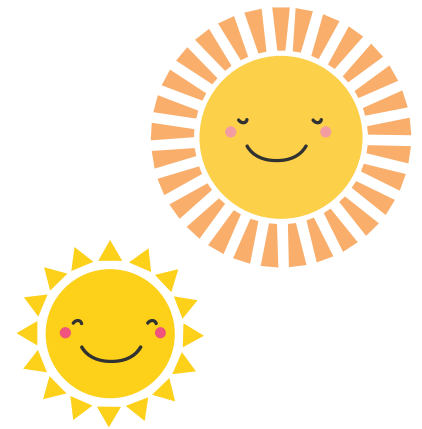
Introducing a new respite program designed to give adults age 55+ a break from their caregiving duties when school is not in session. Caregivers choose from a list of approved camps throughout the region, and the base fees are waived for children who live in their home. *(Age eligibility varies. Please call for info.)*

GRANDPass gives older caregivers:

- Needed relief from caregiving tasks and expenses.
- Peace of mind knowing that their children are being cared for in a safe and structured environment.

GRANDPass gives children:

- A chance to learn and grow.
- Access to the outdoors.
- New friendships.
- Meaningful activities and experiences.



Caregivers must be:

- Age 55 or older.
- Residents of Cass, Clay, Jackson, Platte or Ray counties in Missouri.
- The primary caregiver for children under the age of 18, who live in the same home.
- Grandparents or other related caregivers. Non-relatives who are the legal guardian of their children are eligible, too.

Note: Parents cannot reside with the eligible caregiver and children.
